The Las Ventanas Ranch Mutual Benefit Water Company (LVRMWC) customers were notified in late April that the water supplied by the LVR well contains manganese levels that exceed the secondary MCL standard of 50 ppb, resulting in the need to submit and execute this Corrective Action Plan. We have reviewed the causes of the exceedance and propose the following actions to ensure delivery of water at acceptable levels to our customers and SLO County Health compliance no later than June 30, 2024.
